Open to young men ages 14-22 years, April 3rd-6th, 2026. The goal of this camp is to teach the participants about the Lakota Sciences of the spring season. You'll be learning Lakota horse knowledge, archery, fishing, canoeing, hiking, fossil identification, flint napping, story telling, and Lakota male roles teachings. Participants need to be able to commit to the 3½ days and will be camping out. Camp will be held in the Yellow Bear Canyon Recreational area and the Generations Indigenous Ways Outdoor Campus Badlands, Oglala Lakota Nation, SD. **Camp starts Friday April 3rd at 12pm at Yellow Bear Canyon.** Participants must organize their own rides to camp. We do have sleeping bags available if needed, and water bottles will be provided for all participants. If they do not have a ride we can transport them, please call (605) 454-8425.
